Level 2 - Purple

Training Room Duties

- 1. Student knows how to properly restock cabinets
- 2. Student knows how to clean counters and floors properly
 - a. Counters get cleaned with Iso-Quin
 - b. Floor need to be swept every day and mopped as needed with required cleaning solution
- 3. Student knows how to start laundry, fold and put away items (*included ace wraps)
 - a. Follow instructions on machine
 - b. Laundry needs to be completed at the end of every day or as needed
 - c. Hot Pack covers need to be washed every Wednesday
- 4. Student knows how to complete inventory
 - a. Can count and fill out appropriate paperwork

Injury Care/Wound Care

- 1. Student is able to identify all wound care supplies and knows the purpose of each item.
 - a. Saline solution-irrigation of wounds
 - b. Hydrogen Peroxide- 1st time irrigation **if wound has debris in it.** Can be used to remove blood from uniform
 - c. Gauze- cleaning the wound. Be sure to clean from inside out
 - d. Non-adherant pad- to be placed over wound during practice and competition
 - e. Taping supplies- to secure non-adherant pad to body part
 - f. Band-aids- to be placed on smaller and easily managed wounds
- 2. Student shows understanding of the different wound care sequences done in the training room, during practice and at game
- 3. Student is able to apply wound care procedures with OSHA guidelines

Treatments

- 1. Student knows the theory behind cold whirlpool
 - a. Decrease inflammation
 - b. Constricts blood vessels
 - c. Water provide some form of compression
 - d. Action of water from motor helps remove unwanted fluids from tissues of affected area
- 2. Student knows how to fill up a cold whirlpool
 - a. Temperature needs to be 50 degrees
 - b. Fill tub with 1 trashcan of ice
 - c. 2 pumps of whirlpool disinfectant

- 3. Student knows the theory behind warm whirlpool
 - a. Increase relaxation of tissue
 - b. Dilation of blood vessels
 - c. Action of water from motor helps remove unwanted fluids from tissues of affected area
- 4. Student knows how to fill up a warm whirlpool
 - a. Preferred temperature is 104 and not to exceed 108
- 5. Student is able to properly fill out treatment log
 - a. Completely blanks on treatment log
 - b. Check boxes of all modalities and treatments that the athlete had received

Field Setup

- 1. Student knows how to set up for a sub-varsity football game
 - a. 6-10 gallons
 - b. 2- ice chests
 - c. 2-playmate ice chest with 5 ice bags
 - d. Splints
 - e. Practice kit
 - f. AED
 - g. Yellow equipment kit
- 2. Student knows how to set-up a varsity football game
